I have reviewed your letter seeking a response to a request for information and for a reply as to whether or not a violation of FIC laws have occurred.

I have spoken with with Candidate Brown and he denies any violation(s), however he is willing to discuss the same with your office about any specifics that you all may believe to be a violation.

It is my understanding that that the campaign account begun with proceeds deposited directly by the candidate. These proceeds were used as filing fees and other initial expenses. Thereafter the campaign ran a negative balance to be paid by the candidate. Perhaps there maybe a deficit in accounting but there is no inappropriate use of funds.

Your office may call the undersigned and arrange a telephonic interview with the Candidate should you desire one.
