Please find attached the sworn statement of Bill Randall concerning the complaint by Pat Adams. I have also attached a copy of Pat Adams volunteer sign up sheet. I was not campaign treasurer while Pat Adams was a volunteer for the campaign. I have met Pat Adams at several public campaign events but do not know her on a personal basis.

I add the following to Bill Randall's statement:

(1) There is written documentation in the form of a hand written log book showing miles traveled by Bill Randall on campaign business. All checks issued by the campaign in 2009/10 for travel mileage was based on this log.

(2) The 2009 year end FEC report filed by the previous campaign treasurer Mrs. Pirozzi was audited by a person not associated with the campaign and I was told the report was correct by that person.

(3) The first treasurer for Randall for Congress, Linda Amtie, told me she had no knowledge written or verbal that Pat Adams was to receive a salary from the campaign.


(4) There is no employment contract for Pat Adams in the campaign files.

(5) I was told by the previous treasurer, Mrs. Pirozzi, that Pat Adams was reimbursed for things she purchased for the campaign which she had receipts for and was asked to buy. Some expenses submitted by Pat Adams were not reimbursed because there was no written evidence of said expenses submitted by Pat Adams.

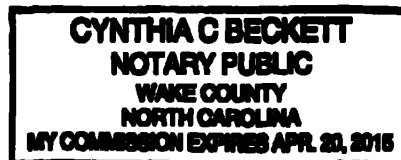

The following is submitted in response to allegations outlined in reference (a).

The totality of the charges levied by Ms. Adams' frivolous, false, unfounded, misleading and/or unsubstantiated.

With respect to her charges against me and my campaign:

a. Volunteer or Employee: Ms. Adams joined my campaign as a volunteer. Enclosure (1) clearly shows that she signed a form that identified persons willing to:

- 1) volunteer
- 2) contribute (financially), or
- 3) become BOTH a willing contributor and volunteer

Since Ms. Adams did not contribute to my campaign on the day she signed up, the only other possibility for her signing up was to serve as a volunteer. Furthermore, no promise of a salary or other monetary compensation was offered. Ms. Adams cannot produce any documentation to substantiate her claim that my campaign made a commitment to pay her for her VOLUNTEER services.

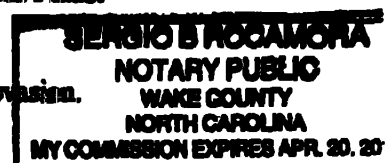
b. Unauthorized Payments by Candidate: Ms. Adams' letter clearly (and correctly) indicates that I paid for my clothing (on Dec 2, 2009) with my personal credit card. While it is true that I received a payment from my campaign, such payment was partial reimbursement for mileage I had accrued. As a matter of fact, total mileage I had driven from the inclusive period July 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009 was over \$3000. Yet, as of Jan 1, 2010, I had received less than \$3000 (including the \$661.59 indicated in Ms. Adams' letter). Each and every payment indicated as mileage reimbursement was, in fact, PARTIAL reimbursement for mileage.

c. Personal Loans from Candidate to his Campaign: With all due respect, I do not owe Ms. Adams any explanation of where the \$11,500 loaned to my campaign came from. I do acknowledge that its source is properly reported on required financial statements (that I must submit to the FEC).

The above is true to the best of my knowledge. It is submitted without purpose of evasion.
