To Whom It May Concern:

The purpose of this letter is to respond to MUR#6329 filed on July 15, 2010 by Stephen Clinton (*attached*). The complaint alleges that Michael Grimm for Congress ("the Grimm campaign") has violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 specifically, §441d, as amended ("the Act") and to demonstrate that no action should be taken against the Grimm campaign in this matter.

The Grimm campaign is fully conscious and aware of the statute requiring that campaign communication "shall clearly state that the communication has been paid for by such authorized political committee..." (§441d). When our first order of lawn signs were delivered, they were missing the "paid for" language as required by statute. Our solution was to take remedial measures by exercising due diligence to print and place stickers containing the "paid for" language on every lawn sign that was missing the aforementioned "paid for" language (*see Exhibits A and B*).

Further, the Grimm campaign ensured that every sign in subsequent deliveries was printed with the requisite "paid for" language. The Grimm campaign consciously and diligently worked to conform to FEC regulations and our campaign takes these regulations very seriously.

Enclosed is photographic evidence of the due diligence that the Grimm campaign exercised to ensure that each sign conformed to FEC regulations. We feel that our response and evidence demonstrates that no action should be taken against our campaign and look forward to your review of this matter.

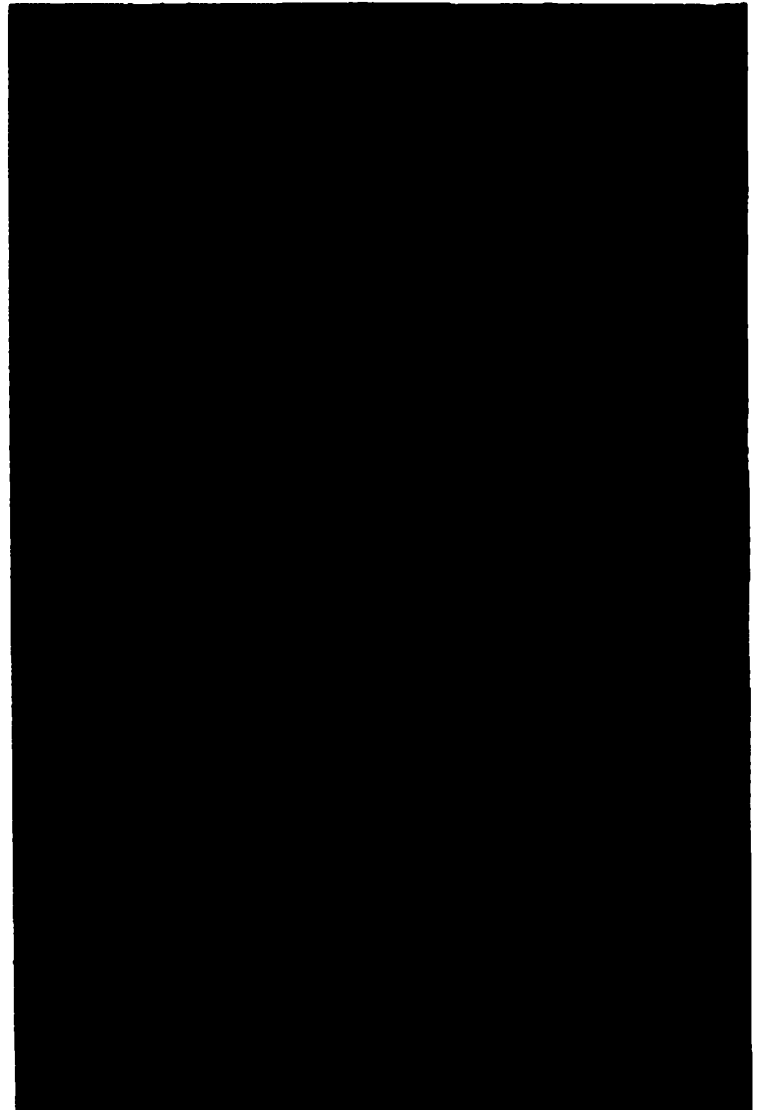
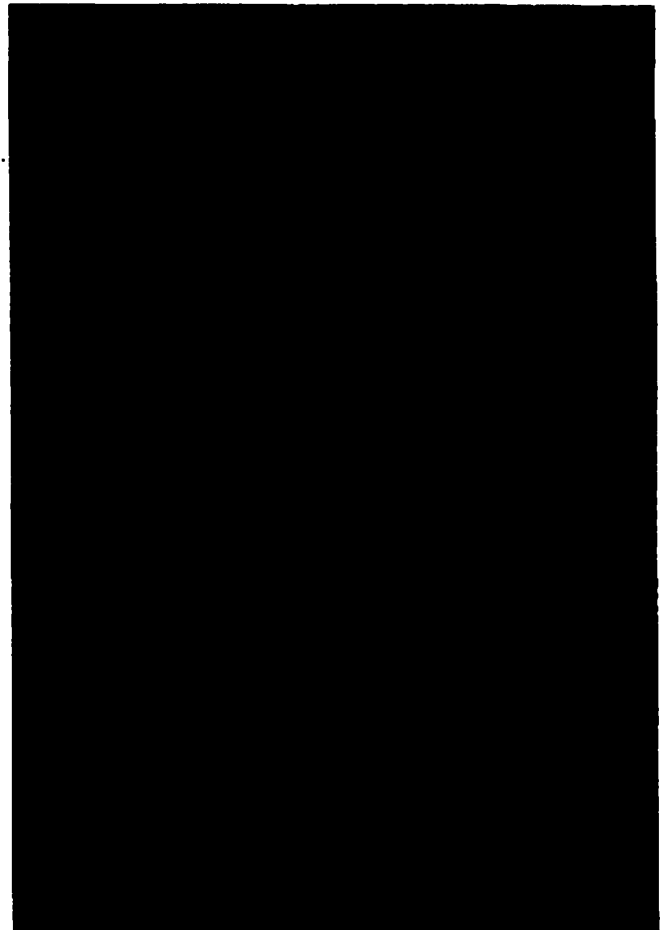
