I am submitting this complaint under the Federal Election Campaign Act and the Rules promulgated thereunder against the two committees identified above. My first complaint is that the Riemersma for Congress Campaign Committee and the Republican Member Senate Fund coordinated public communications in support of Jay Riemersma's candidacy for the Republican nomination from Michigan's Second Congressional District. As further shown below, this has resulted in the Riemersma Campaign Committee receiving an illegal excess contribution from the Republican Member Senate Fund. My second complaint is that the Riemersma Committee has accepted and apparently retained funds from anonymous contributors who gave the Committee in excess of \$50.00.

**A. Coordination of Communications Between the Riemersma Campaign and the Republican Member Senate Fund**

As noted above, Jay Riemersma is running in the Republican Primary for Congress from Michigan's Second Congressional District. In connection with his campaign, he has retained Strategic National Campaign Management LLC ("Strategic National") a Michigan limited liability company, *Exhibit 1*. Indeed, based on a review of the Riemersma Committee's FEC

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filings, from August 28, 2009 through July 14, 2010, the Committee has paid Strategic National at least \$54,202.52. One principal of Strategic National is John Yob, who is also the resident agent of Strategic National. *Id.* John Yob is also a campaign consultant and spokesman for the Riemersma Campaign. See, *Exhibit 2*, articles from various news sources. In addition, Charles Yob also works for Strategic National and is the father of John Yob. See, *Exhibit 3*. Charles Yob was also on the Republican National Committee from 1989 through 2008. *Exhibit 4*.

On information and belief, the Republican Member Senate Fund is controlled by Charles and John Yob. This belief is in part based on the fact that there exists a Michigan corporation known as the Republican Member Senate Fund, whose only officer – albeit holding several officer positions – is Charles Yob, and whose directors include both Charles and John Yob. See, *Exhibit 5*. In addition, the history of filings of the corporation and PAC with both the Michigan Department of Labor and the Federal Elections Commission (“FEC”) supports the inference that the corporation and PAC – if not one and the same – are related. The corporation was originally incorporated on August 2, 2005 as the Republican National Committee Member Senate Fund. Eric Doster, an attorney working in Lansing, Michigan prepared the incorporation papers, and his wife, Mary, is shown as the incorporator. *Exhibit 6*. By letter of August 2, 2005, Eric Doster transmitted a Statement of Organization on an FEC form, creating the Republican National Committee Member Senate Fund, which was signed by Mary Doster, as Treasurer. *Exhibit 7*.

Effective August 23, 2006, the corporate name of the Republican National Committee Member Senate Fund was changed to the Republican Member Senate Fund. *Exhibit 8*. This amendment to change the name of the corporation is signed by Charles Yob. *Id.* On August 27, 2006, the name of the Federal PAC, Republican National Committee Member Senate Fund, was changed to the Republican Member Senate Fund. *Exhibit 9*.<sup>1</sup>

Although the Republican Member Senate Fund has actually contributed precious little to Republican candidates – most of its receipts are apparently consumed in fundraising activities – it did contribute \$5,000.00 – the maximum contribution in any calendar year that a PAC may make to the Riemersma for Congress Committee. *Exhibit 10*, excerpt from the PAC’s FEC filing of July 14, 2009. The first payment by Riemersma for Congress to Strategic National to pay for John Yob’s campaign services was on August 28, 2009. *Exhibit 11*. Interestingly, the Republican Member Senate Fund also paid Strategic National \$5,000.00 on July 8, 2009, for “consulting-strategy.” *Exhibit 12*.

In mid-July 2010, what is apparently the Yob-controlled Republican Member Senate Fund ran “independent” radio advertisements in Grand Rapids and Muskegon, Michigan that promoted candidate Riemersma, while attacking two of Riemersma’s opponents, Bill Huizenga and Wayne Kulpers. The text of this advertisement is transcribed and attached as *Exhibit 13*. Interestingly, the required disclaimer states that the ads were paid for by the Republican Member Committee Fund, which apparently does not exist as a legal entity or PAC. However, there seems to be no doubt that these ads were actually paid for by the Yob-controlled Republican

Member Senate Fund. Attached as *Exhibits 14 and 15* are copies of the agreements between the Republican Member Senate Fund and Citadel Broadcasting and Clear Channel, respectively. These broadcasting companies ran the advertisements on approximately twelve radio stations. The Clear Channel Agreement has attached to it a Political Inquiry form, identifying Chuck (that is, Charles) Yob as the Chairman of the Republican Committee Member Fund (sic) and Mary Doster as its Treasurer – the same Mary Doster who was the original treasurer of both the corporation and PAC Republican Member Senate Fund.<sup>2</sup> The Republican Member Senate Fund paid a gross amount of \$3,036 for the Clear Channel broadcasts, *Exhibit 16*, and \$10,600 for the Citadel Broadcasting spots. *Exhibit 17*.

It is also interesting that the two broadcast agreements were faxed from a machine used by Nevada Republican U.S. Senate candidate Sharron Angle. John Yob and Strategic National also provide campaign services for Sharron Angle. *Exhibit 18*. Moreover, according to the FEC records for the 2009-2010 election cycle, as of June 30, 2010, of \$60,040.00 in disbursements from the Republican Member Senate Fund, only \$16,000.00 was contributed to candidates or political committees – and only \$13,000.00 to actual candidates. Of this amount \$1,000.00 went to Sharron Angle's campaign. *Exhibit 19*. I understand, but do not know for certain, that John Yob was in Nevada on July 13, 2010, when these broadcasting agreements were faxed. These facts show that John Yob continues to be involved with the Republican Member Senate Fund PAC, while at the same time managing the Riemersma campaign.

I contend that the creation and running of these advertisements were the result of coordinated activity between Riemersma for Congress and the Republican Member Senate Fund, thereby resulting in the PAC giving, and the Riemersma committee receiving, an excessive and illegal contribution. "Coordinated communication" is defined in 11 CFR § 109.21(a) as follows:

(a) *Definition.* A communication is coordinated with a candidate, and authorized committee, a political party committee, or an agent of any of the foregoing when the communication:

(1) Is paid for, in whole or in part, by a person other than the candidate, authorized committee, or political party committee;

(2) Satisfies at least one of the content standards in paragraph (c) of this section; and

(3) Satisfies at least one of the conduct standards in paragraph (d) of this section.

The content standards that are a condition precedent to a "coordinated communication" are easily established. While I believe the advertisement constitutes express advocacy for the election of Riemersma and defeat of Bill Hertzberg and Wayne Kuipers, 11 CFR § 109.21 (c)(3),

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at the very least, the advertisement constitutes an "electioneering communication" under 11 CFR § 100.29, thus, satisfying 11 CFR § 109.21(d)(1), as a public communication as defined in 11 CFR § 100.26, with reference to House candidates, thus, satisfying the content standard of 11 CFR § 100.21(c)(4)(i). The advertisements were run within 30 days of the August 3, 2010, Republican primary and clearly identify these candidates running for Congressman from Michigan's Second District. Finally, the radio stations on which the advertisement was run can reach more than 50,000 people within Michigan's Second District, thus qualifying the advertisement as a "electioneering communication." See, 11 CFR § 100.29(b)(7).

I also submit that at least one of the content standards set forth in 11 CFR § 109.21(d) are met. Given that John Yob is being paid through Strategic National by the Riemersma Candidate Committee, Charles Yob's employment with Strategic National, the Republican Member Senate Fund's use of Strategic National as a vendor, and the Yob's apparent control of the Republican Member Senate Fund, it is, simply put, an inherent impossibility for the so-called independent communication not to have been coordinated between the Riemersma Committee and the Republican Member Senate Fund. The Republican Member Senate Fund clearly paid to run the ads.<sup>3</sup> The ads were authorized by the Riemersma Committee through John Yob, who is essentially Riemersma's campaign manager (I don't know his official title with the campaign), and John Yob is, of course, a principal in Strategic National. 11 CFR § 109.21(d)(1). Of necessity, there was also material involvement and substantial discussion between the Riemersma Committee and the Republican Member Senate Fund. See, 11 CFR § 109.21(d)(2) and (3).

Again, the PAC Republican Member Senate Fund, which is almost certainly related to the corporation of the same name shows as its sole officer, Charles Yob and one the directors of this corporation is John Yob. See, *Exhibit 5*. 11 CFR § 109.21(d)(2) and (3). Both Yobs work for Strategic National, both Yobs are directors of the Republican Member Senate Fund, Inc., while Charles Yob is the sole officer of that corporation. The Yobs almost certainly control the PAC of the same name as the corporation. Fundamentally, any expenditure is inherently coordinated where, as here, the same person or people running a candidate's campaign are able through a separate PAC to authorize creation and dissemination of public communications that are intended to benefit the candidate whose campaign they are running.

Now, let's briefly turn to the substance of the advertisement the Republican Member Senate Fund PAC paid to air. This advertisement starts out by attacking candidates Bill Huizenga and Wayne Kuipers for voting for the Michigan Business Tax ("MBT") as state legislators. These votes in favor of the MBT have been a common theme of Riemersma in his stump speech, and Riemersma's campaign website says this about the MBT:

Our state government has been in statistics, unable or unwilling to make the tough choices needed to put Michigan on solid economic footing. Worse yet, several of our own elected officials who

campaigns as conservatives voted to support the disastrous Michigan Business Tax (MBT), which added taxes on numerous businesses in West Michigan and forces them to pay no matter or nor they make a profit. Some voted to support a tax increase on services, and then voted for a "tax on a tax", the MBT surcharge. Republicans from West Michigan should be providing leadership for our state, but instead the compromised conservative principles when in matter most.


In short, John and/or Chuck Yob, through Strategic National counsel the Riemersma committee to emphasize the MBT vote of two of his opponents, and, what a surprise the Republican Member Senate Fund – almost certainly controlled by the Yobs – pay to distribute (and probably create) a radio advertisement that emphasizes the MBT votes as a reason to vote for Riemersma and not Bill Huizenga or Wayne Kuipers in the Republican primary for Congress from Michigan's Second District.

**B. Acceptance of Anonymous Campaign Contributions**

At least in Riemersma for Congress' quarterly disclosure report for July 2010, there are many instances in which the Committee reported accepting anonymous contributions, including four that exceeded \$50.00 each. Attached at *Exhibit 20* is a listing printed off of the FEC website of the retained receipts reported by the Riemersma for Congress Campaign Committee in its July 2010 quarterly report. Page two includes an anonymous contribution of \$52.00, page three an anonymous contribution of \$106.00, and page four, two anonymous contributions in the amounts of \$307.00 and \$449.00, respectively. Anonymous cash contributions in excess of \$50.00 are not supposed to be accepted, but if they are, the amount of each such contribution in excess of \$50.00 is to be promptly disposed by the candidate committee for a purpose unrelated to any federal candidate or election. 11 CFR § 110.4(c)(3). At least as of this date, based on Riemersma's FEC filings, I find no evidence that these excess funds were not simply retained or spent by the Riemersma Campaign Committee to promote Riemersma's candidacy. Therefore, it appears the Committee has retained anonymous funds that are not lawful for it to retain.

The information set forth in this letter complaint are true to the best of my knowledge, information and belief.

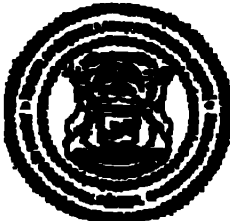

# Former University of Michigan and NFL player Jay Riemersma inches closer to Congressional run with YouTube announcement

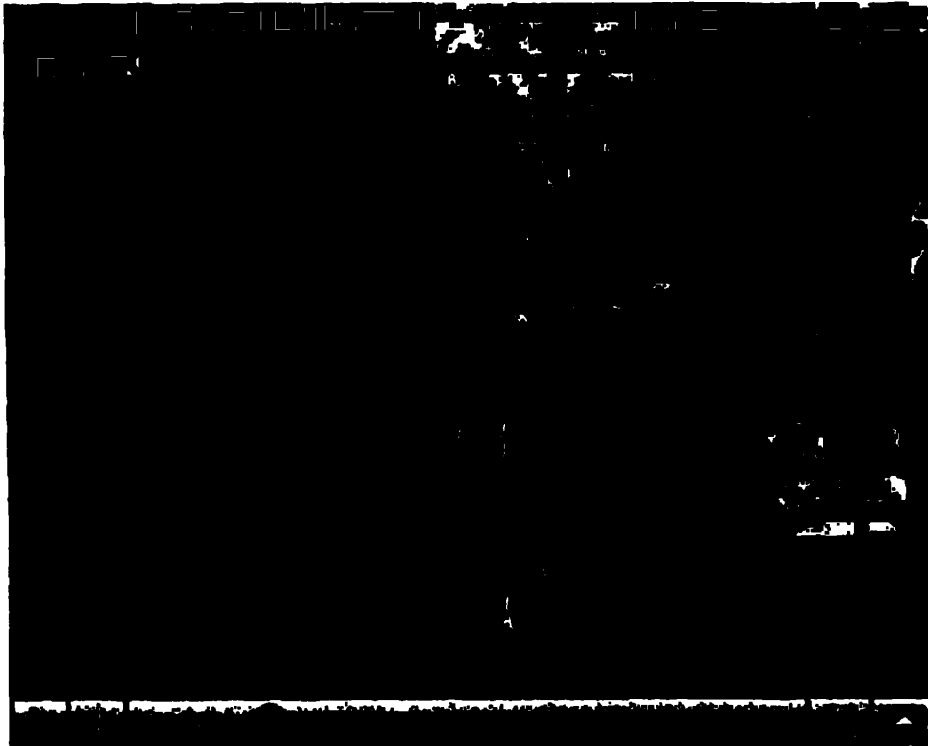

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The letterhead says "Jay Riemersma for Congress," but the official announcement is that the former NFL player from Zeeland is exploring a run.

The Grand Rapids Press reported Wednesday that Riemersma had filed the necessary paperwork with the Federal Elections Commission to run, but he did not return phone calls.

In a news release and YouTube video sent out today, Riemersma said he is "seriously considering" a run for the Congressional seat being vacated by U.S. Rep. Pete Hoekstra, a Holland Republican running for governor.



Riemersma has hired Republican political consultant John Yob, a Byron Township resident who was deputy

political director for Sen. John McCain's 2008 presidential campaign. Yob, who recently established an office in Grand Rapids, is also working for GOP gubernatorial candidate Rick Snyder, of Ann Arbor.

Riemersma's opening statements indicate he will use Hoekstra's 1992 strategy when he upset long-time Rep. Goy VanderJagt in 1992 by tapping into a "no more politics as usual" movement.

"Pete was an excellent congressman and will make an excellent governor," Riemersma said. "When he came to office he defeated the status quo because voters were tired of politics as usual."

Riemersma, 36, was a gridiron standout at Zeeland High School and the University of Michigan who was not drafted after college but went on to play nine years in the NFL for the Buffalo Bills and Pittsburgh Steelers. He caught 221 passes for 2,524 yards and scored 23 touchdowns in 112 NFL games.

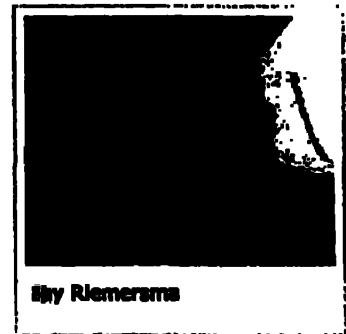
Backers say Jay Riemersma's status as a political outsider is helping him take a commanding lead in raising money for the race to fill the U.S. House seat in the 2nd District.

But other candidates say the businessman and former football player started focusing on generating cash early in the game, and there's plenty of time to catch up.

Four candidates are seeking the Republican nomination for the seat, which Rep. Pete Hoekstra is giving up as he runs for governor. Fred Johnson is seeking the Democratic line on the ballot.

According to reports submitted to the Federal Election Commission, Riemersma has raised the most cash by far -- \$252,050 -- and also loaned his campaign \$100,000 in the reporting period that ended Dec. 31.

He's also spent the most so far: \$213,356.

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### The money in the U.S. House race

Candidates seeking the Republican nomination for the 2nd Congressional District reported their fundraising through the end of 2009.

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With state Sen. Wayne Kulpers and Bill Huizenga, a former state House member, in the race, Riemersma is tapping into voter unrest in the district, which stretches along the state western shore, said campaign spokesman John Yob.

"People are turning against the career politicians," Yob said. "They're unhappy with the way things are in the state, and the career politicians are the ones who got us into the mess. The voter sentiments that led to Scott Brown winning in Massachusetts and the governorships in New Jersey and Virginia are coming into play here in Michigan."

Yob said Riemersma has collected money from more than 3,000 donors, including two \$500 contributions from Washington Redskins quarterback Todd Collins, who played football with Riemersma on the Buffalo Bills and the University of Michigan.

Muskegon businessman Bill Cooper said he, too, is gaining support from folks angry with the way the state has been run. Cooper has the second-largest war chest -- \$206,772 -- but has loaned his campaign \$150,000, more than anyone else in the race.

"I'm probably the worst fundraiser," he said. "I'm putting a lot of my own money in there. But day after day, I'm speaking to groups and people come up to me and say, 'Bill, I want to give you some money to run.'"

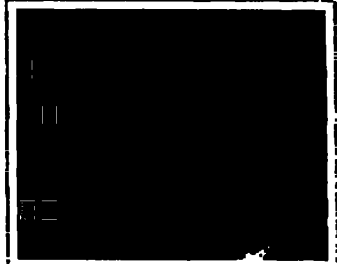
Cooper said small business owners often bring up Huizenga's and Kulpers' votes in favor of the Michigan Business Tax.

"People think that tax chased 10,000 businesses from the state," Cooper said. "I'm up against two politicians and a football player, and I'm the one who has provided jobs to people over the years."

Cooper said Riemersma's bottom line is misleading, saying that while Riemersma has raised a lot of money, he spent a lot, too, on fundraising groups. Records show Riemersma has spent \$213,356 so far, about twice as much as Huizenga, the second biggest spender.

Huizenga, the former state representative from Zoeland, reported raising \$151,387 with \$44,677 left in the bank, and loaning his campaign \$12,500 so far.

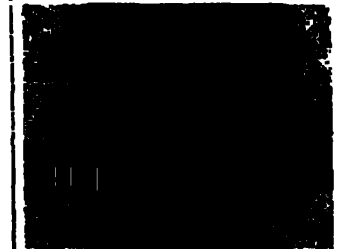
His donor list includes numerous Lakeshore business and community leaders, including various members of the DeVos and Van Andel families and Jim and Donna Brooks.



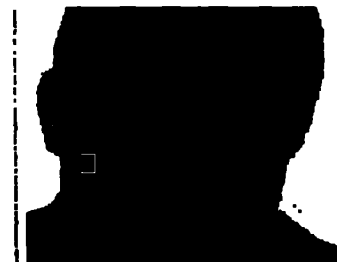
Wayne Kulpers

Huizenga could not be reached for comment.

Kulpers has raised the least, \$57,915, but also has spent the least, just \$2,935, and has not spent his own money, according to the federal records.

Kulpers, chairman of the Senate's Education Committee, said he was too busy working on legislation needed for the state's Race to the Top school reform application to focus on the congressional race in the final months of 2009.

"We've been a little busy," he said. "But we have a lot of cash in hand, and the amount we've raised so far shows we're in the hunt. We have a plan, and we will have the cash we need to be competitive in this race."

Johnson, an associate professor of American history at Hope College, raised \$7,291 and spent \$9,561 and loaned his campaign \$1,000, records show. He has \$1,164 in cash reserves.

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## Jay Riemersma sued by fellow Republican Bill Cooper over alleged campaign smear tactics

OTTAWA COUNTY -- Accusing his opponent of smearing his reputation during some recent door-to-door campaigning, Norton Shores businessman Bill Cooper has filed suit against fellow Republican Jay Riemersma, as both vie for the 2nd Congressional seat held by outgoing U.S. Rep. Pete Hoekstra.

Cooper said he filed the lawsuit against the former NFL player earlier this month in Ottawa County Circuit Court.

He alleges one of Riemersma's campaign volunteers knowingly spread false statements about Cooper while campaigning last month. Both men are vying for the Republican nomination for Michigan's 2nd Congressional District.

The suit names Riemersma, his campaign, and volunteer Vincent Bush.

"I had numerous people calling me and telling me what Jay and his campaign staff were saying, and I had

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had enough. I had to do something," Cooper said Tuesday. "We did what we thought we had to do to make sure they were truthful."

Cooper says his lawsuit targets claims Riemersma's campaign allegedly made regarding Cooper's financial practices -- specifically, that a business Cooper owned was foreclosed upon due to unpaid property taxes. Cooper claims Riemersma hired people to investigate Cooper's business background, and although he had paid some taxes late, that money was accounted for well before any checks would have been done.

"He was saying I had a business that was foreclosed upon when they did a record search of my property," Cooper said. "It was the equivalent of returning a library book late. I had specific reasons for paying taxes late. They knew I was paid current."

Cooper also calls into question a claim that he resided in Arizona and returned to Michigan just in time to throw his name into the race for Hoekstra's seat. While he acknowledges he is out of state for one- or two-month periods -- he maintains a business in Arizona -- Cooper says he has never called that state his permanent home. "I have spent a lot of time in Arizona. I have never resided in Arizona," he said.

Riemersma, of Holland, did not return messages left at his office or home Tuesday night.

A Riemersma campaign adviser declined to comment on Cooper's claims other than to say Cooper "should be ashamed of himself" for wasting tax dollars on his political campaign by seeking court action.

"This is a desperate attempt by an irrelevant candidate to try and generate publicity by trying to attack a campaign volunteer," adviser John Tob said. "Voters in West Michigan are just going to appreciate someone trying to waste their tax dollars."

Smaller, More Subdued Mackinac Conference Kicks Off (MACKINAC ISLAND) -- The annual Detroit Regional Chamber of Commerce Mackinac Policy Conference kicked off today in an atmosphere that was colder, wetter and a bit more subdued than in past years.

The big news story hanging over much of Detroit and Michigan is the impending bankruptcy of General Motors and what that bankruptcy could mean.

That very bankruptcy took away from the conference a major annual sponsor. For years, General Motors has sponsored the bag of goodies given to each attendee upon arrival. This year, the gift bags were sponsored by the Detroit Auto Dealers and the North American International Auto Show -- which was interestingly considering the major policy/political battle on their hands with the on-again, off-again Cobo Hall expansion proposals.

The gift bags contained the ever-present box of Grand Hotel fudge, four empty travel bottles, a Roseman Public Relations Lobby Guide and a toothbrush. In past years Northwest Airlines had gotten into PR hot water by giving out free urine bottles and last year one out of five bags contained a free BlackBerry.

Chamber Survey: Optimism On The Rise

What's the old saying? There's nowhere to go but up?

**Yob Joins Strategic National**

Former Republican National Committee Vice-Chairman Chuck YOB has joined his son's political consulting firm, Strategic National, as the senior advisor to the company focusing on state conventions and state House candidate recruitment.

He will also be focused on recruiting Republican candidates for State House races across Michigan. In 1992 and again in 1994, Minority Leader Paul HILLBOMOND and Governor John ENGELER put him in charge of State House candidate recruitment.

"I am looking forward to getting involved in convention races at all levels and helping nominate candidates who are conservative on the issues, have what it takes to win in November, and make a solid ticket," Yob said.

Said Strategic National CEO John Patrick YOB, "There is no crumtier at convention strategy and persuasion than Chuck Yob and we look forward to putting him to work. We will announce the campaigns that we are assisting in the next few weeks."

**Van Weerhoren Bill Lets Pharmacists Carry Marijuana**

Sen. Gerald VAN WEEERHOREN (R-Norton Shores) today introduced legislation that would develop necessary regulations for medical marijuana use in Michigan, including letting pharmacists buy medical marijuana from among 10 licensed growers.

Under SB 0516, the state would inspect the licensed farms once a year and those who violate the law face two years in prison. The bill comes after voters approved in November a ballot proposal legalizing medical marijuana.

"I did not vote for the ballot initiative, but now that medical marijuana is legal, the state must establish an approach to make sure that it is being grown and used appropriately," Van Weerhoren said. "This package of bills requires records on who is using and growing medical marijuana to help ensure that it is not used for recreational purposes. It also protects patients by making sure they are receiving the intended dose and that the drugs are not contaminated."

**James Introduces Legislator Benefit Bill**

Rep. Ed JONES (R-Grand Haven) today introduced legislation to stop special lifetime health insurance legislation for House speakers and managers elected after Oct. 25th. Jones, himself, would not receive health benefits under his bill.

Currently, those elected to the Legislature receive health insurance in retirement as a benefit after only six years of service. Under HB 5018, lawmakers will wait only after 10 years of service, earning 80 percent of paid health care and then 3 percent more for each year thereafter.

"It's obscene for legislators to get lifetime health benefits after only serving six years, especially when the state is facing such massive budget deficits," Jones said. "Michigan taxpayers shouldn't have to pay for lifetime health care benefits for lawmakers who work only six years."

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# Longtime GOP committeeman Yob to step down

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Veteran GOP National Committeeman Chuck Yob today said he will step down, weeks after he declared his campaign for another term.

Yob appeared overwhelmed by support for Southfield minister Keith Butler, who finished second in the 2006 primary for U.S. Senate. In the past few days, Butler locked up the support of nine of 15 district party chairs and was regarded by GOP party chairman Saul Anuzis to have a virtual lock on the post.

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"I just don't want to tear the party apart," said Yob, a former Grand Rapids businessman who has been on the committee since 1989.

In a statement to party activists, Yob said: "I am nothing if not loyal, some would say to a fault.

"I greatly appreciate every ounce of support that you have given me, and more importantly given our successful Republican candidates over the last 40 years. It is appreciated and will not be forgotten."

Yob has a history of conflict with Anuzis, who said Yob "has served the party well."

He added: "I'm disappointed he appears to be so bitter, but I look forward to working with him in the future."

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ARTICLE VI

A. Volunteer Director and Officer Liability. A volunteer director or a volunteer officer shall not be personally liable to the Corporation or its members for any damages for a breach of the director's or officer's fiduciary duty as a director or officer, except in liability: (a) For any breach of the director's or officer's duty of loyalty to the Corporation or its members; (b) For any act or omission not in good faith or that involves intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of law; (c) For any violation of Section 561(1) of the Michigan Nonprofit Corporation Act, as amended (the "Act"); (d) For any transaction from which the director or officer derived an improper personal benefit; (e) For any act or omission that is grossly negligent; or (f) For any act or omission occurring before the date this article is filed with the Michigan Department of Labor & Economic Growth.

B. Assumption of Volunteer Director Liability. The Corporation assumes all liability to any person, other than the Corporation or its members for all acts or omissions of a volunteer Director occurring on or after the effective date of these Articles of Incorporation and incurred in the good faith performance of the volunteer Director's duties as such.

C. Assumption of Volunteer Liability. The Corporation assumes all liability to any person for the acts or omissions of a volunteer director, volunteer officer or other volunteer occurring on or after the effective date of this article, provided that all of the following conditions are met:

- (1) The volunteer was acting or reasonably believed that he or she was acting within the scope of his or her authority.
- (2) The volunteer was acting in good faith.
- (3) The volunteer's conduct did not amount to gross negligence or willful and wanton misconduct.
- (4) The volunteer's conduct was not an intentional tort.
- (5) The volunteer's conduct was not a tort arising out of the ownership, maintenance or use of a motor vehicle for which tort liability may be imposed under Section 3136 of the Insurance Code of 1956, Act No. 219 of the Public Acts of 1956.

D. Amendment of Liability Law. For purposes of this article, a volunteer director shall mean a director who does not receive anything of more than nominal value from the Corporation for serving as a director other than reasonable per diem compensation and reimbursement for actual, reasonable, and necessary expenses incurred by the director in his or her capacity as a director.

For purposes of this article, a volunteer officer shall mean an officer who does not receive anything of more than nominal value from the Corporation for serving as an officer other than reasonable per diem compensation and reimbursement for actual, reasonable, and necessary expenses incurred by the officer in his or her capacity as an officer.

In the event the Act is amended after the filing of this article of the Articles of Incorporation with the Michigan Department of Labor & Economic Growth to substitute corporate action further eliminating or reducing the personal liability of volunteers, then the liability of volunteers of the Corporation shall be eliminated or limited to the extent extent permitted by the Act, as an amendment, except to the extent such limitation or substitution is inconsistent with the status of the Corporation as a nonprofit corporation.

Any repeal, modification or expiration of any provision in these Articles of Incorporation inconsistent with this article shall not adversely affect any right or protection of a volunteer of the Corporation existing at the time of such repeal, modification or adoption.

ARTICLE VII


A. Indemnification of Directors and Officers. The Corporation shall indemnify any and all persons who may serve as directors and officers (whether or not a volunteer director or officer) against any and all expenses including attorneys' fees in connection with his/her defense in a judicial or administrative proceeding involving assessments or penalties under the Internal Revenue Code or Michigan law relating to mismanagement of funds of charitable organizations to the extent that such expenses are reasonably incurred in connection with such proceeding and provided that such director and officer is successful in such defense or such proceeding is terminated by settlement, and that he/she has not acted willfully but in good faith with reasonable cause to believe that his/her actions or failures to act were not in violation of the Code or laws and were in the best interest of the Corporation. The payment of such expenses by the Corporation shall not include the payment of losses, penalties, expenses or correction, or any other amount for which such director and officer shall be held liable. Any indemnification hereunder shall be made only after determination that indemnification of such director or officer is proper in the circumstances because he/she has met the standards of conduct set forth herein. Such determination shall be made by either a majority vote of a quorum of the Board of Directors consisting of three directors who were not parties to such proceedings or, if such quorum is not obtainable, by written opinion of independent legal counsel selected by those directors not acting in such proceedings.

**B. 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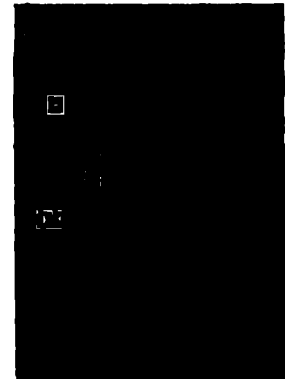

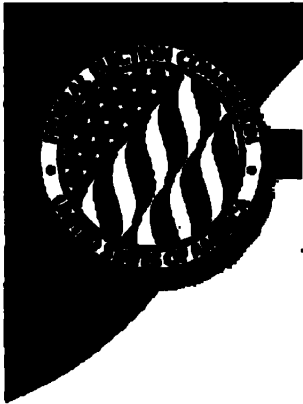

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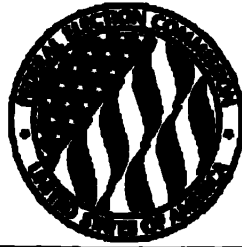
