I am responding to the complaint filed July 28 by Carolyn Sampson, the Communications Director for Shelley Madore for Congress.

The assertions on the Financial Disclosure Report are unwarranted. Dan dated the report January 1, 2009 to June 28, 2010. During that time he did not work for Sela Roofing. He listed an inheritance on the report from the prior year.

There is an error on the prior FEC report which has been identified and the report is being amended.

Only expenses over \$200 are required to be itemized. All of our expenses under \$200 are accounted for in non-itemized expenses. If an expense was over \$200 it is listed as itemized.

We have no campaign phones and our rent is paid to the DFL Coordinated Campaign and includes utilities. Our Pre-Primary report contains our payment for the campaign Post Office Box.

As the DFL Endorsed Candidate we work with the DFL Coordinated Campaign and have use of certain shared office supplies, phones, printers and staff. Any office supplies purchased by the campaign are included in the non-itemized sections of our FEC reports.

Ms. Sampson is incorrect in her assertions about our access to certain voter databases, specifically the Voter Activation Network (VAN). We had limited access to the DFL Party voter file and are working with the DFL Party now to determine what the payment will be following the primary. Our primary database, NGP, is included on our reports as an itemized expense.

Ms. Sampson is incorrect in her assertions about the annual DFL Party Humphrey Day fundraising dinner. As a DFL endorsed candidate, we were listed in the program, and there was no cost. Additionally, our July FEC report reflects an itemized payment for 2 dinners paid to the DFL Party for a total of \$250.

Lastly, Ms. Sampson is incorrect in her assertion regarding parade fees. All parades with registration fees are included in our FEC reports. If the parade fee was over \$200 it is listed as itemized and if the fee was less than \$200 it is listed as non-itemized.



The parade is on Sunday, July 18, 2010 at 12 noon.

Please follow all instructions as to where you should enter the parade staging area and how to coordinate your participants. There are over 100 units that need to be lined up and we need everyone's cooperation.

The Parade route starts at 10<sup>th</sup> and Tyler Streets and proceeds to 2<sup>nd</sup> Street continuing to Eddy Street where the parade will end at Wilson Park.

YOUR UNIT NUMBER IS 80  
ENTER THE PARADE STAGING AREA AT 18<sup>th</sup> Street (Hwy 291)  
PROCEED TO 10<sup>th</sup> Street (Smead Blvd)  
YOUR LINE UP TIME IS 11:40 PLEASE DO NOT BE LATE!

As the recipient of this information, it is your responsibility to notify your unit participants about this information. Access to the staging area is limited and only vehicles in the parade will be allowed to enter the staging area. If there is a concern about young children or members of your group getting to your unit, make sure you have made arrangements for a meeting location prior to parade day. We will not allow hundreds of parents access to the staging area to drop off their child so please plan accordingly.

The parade route is approximately 1.6 miles. You may not throw candy or promotional items from vehicles or floats, you must have walkers along to distribute any giveaways. We request that stickers not be distributed as they end up on fire hydrants, signs and storefront windows and require additional clean up.

Walkers must keep pace with any support vehicles and the vehicles must keep pace with the unit in front of them. If you would like to talk with people along the route, we suggest you start at the end of the route and work your way back to the beginning during the line-up time. It is rude to hold up the parade by not keeping pace with the unit in front of you. Excessive gaps take away from the parade experience and cause the crowd to leave which is not fair to the units toward the end of the parade. Parade monitors will be watching for gaps and if your unit is the cause of a gap, we will take note for future years to put your unit in the back of the parade.

If your parade unit has participants that need to be picked up at the end of the parade route, we recommend that you meet at the High School as there is plenty of parking and it is a distance from the parade end so there is not as much congestion. You will not be allowed to stop at Wilson Park.

Please remember to bring plenty of water for your participants, and be prepared for the warm weather. Listen to the weather forecast. Use your best judgment since there is no shelter in the staging area or along the route. If there is a warning issued during parade time, please check the Chamber's web site at [www.hastingsmn.org](http://www.hastingsmn.org) for any updates. If it is raining, the parade will be held as scheduled and no refunds will be issued.

The Rivertown Days theme is Whatever Floats Your Boat. This is to call attention to a new event that will feature boats or rafts made out of recycled materials racing on Lake Rebecca. Let's make the parade entertaining. All units must be decorated. They must provide entertainment value to the parade. Your acceptance into the parade was based on the unit description submitted with your application. If you arrive for the parade with just a vehicle with a logo on it, you will not be allowed in the line up.
