On August 17, 2010, the Federal Election Commission notified Brumberg for Congress ("Committee"), Anna Shearer and you, as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On February 1, 2011, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by you, that there is no reason to believe the Committee or you violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 441a(f) and 434b. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.
