Dear Ms. O'Donnell:

In a letter dated November 20, 2014, the Federal Election Commission notified you and the Friends of Christine O'Donnell Committee ("Committee") that it found probable cause to believe that you and the Committee violated 52 U.S.C. § 30114(b) (formerly 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b)). The Commission also approved a conciliation agreement to resolve these violations, and informed you that we must attempt to negotiate a settlement for at least 30 days.

As we discussed during our telephone conversation on December 17, the 30-day period for negotiating a conciliation agreement in this matter expires tomorrow. To date, you have not submitted any counteroffers or engaged in discussions demonstrating an interest in conciliating this matter on behalf of yourself or the Committee. Further, following our telephone conversation, it is our understanding that you will not be submitting any counteroffer to the Commission. It is our intention, therefore, upon the expiration the mandatory 30-day conciliation period, to proceed to the Commission with a recommendation to file a civil suit against you and the Committee.
