Dear Ms. O'Donnell:

You were previously notified that on November 18, 2014, the Federal Election Commission found probable cause to believe that you and Friends of Christine O'Donnell and Matthew Moran in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30114(b) (formerly 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b)), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, in connection with the above-referenced matter. As a result of our inability to settle this matter through conciliation within the allowable time period, the Commission has authorized the General Counsel to institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court. Please be advised that the Litigation Division is filing this civil suit today, January 5, 2015.
