On September 30, 2010, the Federal Election Commission notified Dan Seals for Congress ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On May 19, 2011, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by the Committee and you, as treasurer, that there is no reason to believe Dan Seals for Congress and you, in your official capacity as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 441a(a)(1) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 110.1(b)(3) and 110.2(b)(3). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003).
