Attached you will find a copy of the donation made by TransCanada Keystone Pipeline to The Governor Dave Heineman Committee. The donation of \$2,500 was reported to Nebraska Accountability and Disclosure on 01/26/2010. On the Campaign Statement, filed with Nebraska Accountability and Disclosure on 04/12/2010, the \$2,500 donation from TransCanada Keystone Pipeline to The Governor Dave Heineman Committee is listed with the corporate street address of 450 1st Street, Omaha NE. A simple Google search of 450 1st Street shows that 450 1st Street S.W. in Calgary, Alberta is the Canadian corporate headquarters of TransCanada Energy, Ltd. The Omaha office of TransCanada Keystone Pipeline is located at 13710 FNB Parkway in Omaha. If the donation originated from the Omaha office of TransCanada, then why is the address in Calgary listed on the NADC Form B-1 filed on 04/12/2010?

From FEC 110.20. Foreign nationals are prohibited from making contributions, donations or expenditures in connection with any election—federal, state or local. Also, foreign nationals may not donate to any party committee building fund or fund electioneering communications

Definition of Foreign National The following entities are considered foreign nationals and are therefore subject to the prohibition: foreign governments, foreign political parties, foreign corporations, foreign associations, foreign partnerships....

TransCanada Energy, Ltd is a foreign corporation headquartered in Calgary, Alberta, Canada.

I ask that you kindly investigate if The Governor Dave Heineman Committee violated FEC regulations by accepting a donation from a Foreign National.


