RE: Complaint against Alaska Standing Together, Jason Moore, Arctic Slope Regional Corporation Ahtna, Inc., Bering Straits Native Corporation, Calista Corporation, Chugach Alaska Corporation, Sealaska Corporation, NANA Regional Corporation, Koniag, Inc., and Doyon, Ltd., Respondents

To the Office of General Counsel:

Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) and 11 C.F.R. § 111.4, the Joe Miller for U.S. Senate campaign hereby files this Complaint against Alaska Standing Together and its operator, Jason Moore (collectively "AST"). The respondent AST is an independent expenditures PAC registered with the Federal Election Commission ("FEC"). The other respondents are donors to the AST and are corporations that are also federal contractors, namely Arctic Slope Regional Corporation Ahtna, Inc., Bering Straits Native Corporation, Calista Corporation, Chugach Alaska Corporation, Sealaska Corporation, NANA Regional Corporation, Koniag, Inc., and Doyon, Ltd., Respondents (collectively, "Respondents").

Complainant herein is the Joe Miller for U.S. Senate Committee, the principal authorized committee of Joe Miller, Republican nominee for the U.S. Senate from Alaska ("Complainant").

This complaint is filed against Respondents for violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act" or "FECA") and the FEC regulations that specifically prohibit federal contractors from making contributions or expenditures related to federal elections. See 2 U.S.C. §438(a)(10) and 11 C.F.R. §115.1 *et seq.* The respondents have willfully and knowingly violated federal law. Each is a federal contractor. Each has used money obtained as a federal contractor to attempt to influence a federal election.

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Facts of the Violation

AST is a PR front group supporting Lisa Murkowski. It was formed by the following corporations, each of whom has obtained federal contracts, many through earmarks from Murkowski:

- Ahtna, Incorporated
- Aleut Corporation
- Arctic Slope Regional Corporation
- Bristol Bay Native Corporation
- Bering Straits Native Corporation
- Calista Corporation
- Chugach Alaska Corporation
- Cook Inlet Region, Inc.
- Doyon, Limited
- Koniag, Incorporated
- NANA Regional Corporation
- Sealaska Corporation

<http://www.alaskansstandingtogether.org/re-elect-lisa-murkowski/> Attached as Exhibit A are the website pages for AST. Its operator is respondent Jason Moore.

The respondents are each Alaska Native corporations who are members of the Alaska 8(a) Association, and boast that they "are major suppliers of goods and services to the federal government" (Alaska 8(a) Association Mission Statement) (available at [http://www.fea.gov/Documents/OPMworkshop_files/Alaska%208\(a\)%20Association%20FEA%20October%2023.ppt](http://www.fea.gov/Documents/OPMworkshop_files/Alaska%208(a)%20Association%20FEA%20October%2023.ppt)).

The federal money diverted to these entities is astonishing. As reported by Sen. McCaskill: "Between 2000 and 2008, ANCs [Alaska Native Corporations] received **\$6.8 billion** in 8(a) sole-source contracts." <http://mccaskill.senate.gov/files/documents/pdf/2010.10.06AlaskaNativeCorporationLegislation.pdf> In addition to the no competition sole source contracts, Sen. McCaskill revealed that these companies have received "more than \$23 billion in federal contracts." <http://mccaskill.senate.gov/files/documents/pdf/2010.10.06AlaskaNativeCorporationLegislation.pdf>

Recently it was learned that nine of these corporate entities that are part of the scheme that has received billions in federal funds and contract with the federal government, have contributed a total of \$805,000 to AST, which has now reported making "independent"

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expenditures in the U.S. Senate race in support of Lisa Murkowski, totaling over \$595,000 to date. See Exhibit B, AST's FEC October Quarterly Report.

The \$805,000 solicited by Jason Moore and AST was illegal since they were soliciting this money from known federal contractors. Further, the donations by these federal contractors was illegal. These nine corporations brag that "Congressional delegations across all states have packed our wood and water for a long time." (Alaska 8(a) Association Statement) [http://www.fea.gov/Documents/OPMworkshop_files/Alaska%208\(a\)%20Association%20FEA%20October%2023.ppt](http://www.fea.gov/Documents/OPMworkshop_files/Alaska%208(a)%20Association%20FEA%20October%2023.ppt)). Such public bragging about buying off politicians is one thing, but to now use federal money to buy off an election to keep a senator who is on their payroll is patently illegal.

Respondent Arctic Slope Regional Corp. and Doyon have accepted hundreds of millions in federal monies and recently wrote a letter stating that "Our corporations are, by definition, true corporation citizens, and 8(a) is a critical component to our community. The financial and societal impacts of Alaska Native corporations and their 8(a) companies cannot be overstated." (Arctic Slope Regional and Doyon Press Release) ([http://www.asrc.com/pdf/press/OpEd%20Final%20Proposing%208\(a\)%20change.pdf](http://www.asrc.com/pdf/press/OpEd%20Final%20Proposing%208(a)%20change.pdf)). So "critical" is this money that they have brazenly violated federal election law to keep the billions rolling in.

Respondent Bering Straits Corporation states that "Several of our companies provide services to U. S. government agencies including the Army, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard, Army Corps of Engineers, and the US Department's of Commerce, Justice, Agriculture, and Homeland Security." <http://www.beringstraits.com/northriver/wb/pages/company.php> Yet it donated to AST, and Jason Moore illegally solicited funds from this federal contractor.

Respondent Ahtna states that it has "subsidiaries . . . involved in government contracting." <http://www.ahtna-inc.com/> Ahtna further states that it supports "Limited-competition opportunities in the government arena" and proclaims that "through sole-source contracts, businesses are given an opportunity to enter the government contracting arena." <http://www.ahtna-inc.com/opcc.html> Knowing this, Jason Moore illegally solicited Ahtna for funds, and Ahtna illegally donated funds.

Each respondent has received millions of federal dollars. And, it is no secret that Lisa Murkowski, the direct beneficiary of these illegally donated funds, has consistently tried to steer federal money to these supporters. (Attached is a letter from Lisa Murkowski attempting to block any changes that might hinder her ability to divert taxpayer money to these donors. http://www.national8aassociation.org/images/stories/pdf/16-111909_murkowski.pdf).

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Legal Basis of Violations

Title 2 USC §441c(a) specifically prohibits federal contractors from making a contribution to a federal political committee and prohibits a political committee from soliciting contributions from a federal contractor:

"2 U.S.C. §441c.

(a) Prohibition.

It shall be unlawful for any person -

(1) who enters into any contract with the United States or any department or agency thereof either for the rendition of personal services or furnishing any material, supplies, or equipment to the United States or any department or agency thereof or for selling any land or building to the United States or any department or agency thereof, if payment for the performance of such contract or payment for such material, supplies, equipment, land, or building is to be made in whole or in part from funds appropriated by the Congress; at any time between the commencement of negotiations for and the later of:

(A) the completion of performance under; or

(B) the termination of negotiations for, such contract or furnishing of material, supplies, equipment, land, or buildings, directly or indirectly to *make any contribution of money or other things of value, or to promise expressly or impliedly to make any such contribution to any political party, committee, or candidate for public office or to any person for any political purpose or use; or*

(2) knowingly to solicit any such contribution from any such person for any such purpose during any such period."

Federal law prohibiting the use of federal funds for political purposes is clear - and Respondents Jason Moore and AST have violated the statute by soliciting such funds from the contractor donor Respondents and each of them have violated federal law by contributing federal contractor funds for a political purposes.

Indeed, there are numerous restrictions in federal law imposed upon entities and individuals who contract with the federal government to ensure that federal tax dollars are not used for such things as lobbying or political activities.

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The Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) at Parts 31.205-20 and 31.205-50, covering contracts and financial assistance with commercial organizations; and Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Circulars on Cost Principles, including OMB Circular A-87, Cost Principles for State, Local, and Indian Tribal Governments (among others) contain further directives that specifically prohibit the use of federal funds for any election-related or lobbying activities. Generally, the various directives contain almost identical provisions restricting the allowability of costs associated with lobbying and political activities, a summary of some of the unallowable lobbying provisions is provided below:

- *Attempts to influence the outcomes of any Federal, State, or local election, referendum, initiative, or similar procedures, through in kind or cash contributions, endorsements, publicity, or similar activities;*
- *Establishing, administering, contributing to, or paying the expenses of a political party, campaign, political action committee, or other organization established for the purpose of influencing the outcomes of elections;*
- *Any attempt to influence the introduction, or the enactment or modification of any pending, Federal, state, or local legislation through communication with any member or employee of the Congress or state legislature (including efforts to influence state or local officials to engage in similar lobbying activity), or with any government official or employee in connection with a decision to sign or veto enrolled legislation;*
- *Any attempt to influence the introduction, or the enactment or modification of any pending, Federal, state, or local legislation by preparing, distributing or using publicity or propaganda, or by urging members of the general public or any segment thereof to contribute to or participate in any mass demonstration, march, rally, fund raising drive, lobbying campaign or letter writing or telephone campaign;*
- *Legislative liaison activities, including attendance at legislative sessions or committee hearings, gathering information regarding legislation, and analyzing the effect of legislation, when such activities are carried on in support of or in knowing preparation for an effort to engage in unallowable activities;*

Further, a provision commonly referred to as the Byrd Amendment (31 U.S.C. 1352) prohibits the use of Federal contract, grant, loan or cooperative agreement funds to pay any person for influencing or attempting to influence the executive or legislative branch with respect to certain specified actions. Any person who requests or receives a Federal contract, grant, loan or cooperative agreement is required to file a certification that no payments prohibited by the Byrd amendment have been made using appropriated funds, and a declaration providing

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information with respect to any payments made using other than appropriated funds. *Violations of the Byrd amendment may result in the imposition of civil penalties of \$10,000 or more*

Clearly, Respondents have violated numerous provisions of federal law in utilizing funds from federal contractors to influence a federal election. Further, the actions engaged in by Respondents constitute willful and knowing violations of federal law, and both civil and criminal penalties for such violations must be imposed. See 2 U.S.C. §4375(B) and (C).

The actions of Jason Moore, using AST as a front, to solicit these federal contractors to give federal money to fund Lisa Murkowski's campaign is likely criminal and an investigation and prosecution is needed. This is election fraud and criminal diversion of federal money.

Conclusion

Upon information and belief, and based upon the facts in the public record, Respondents have violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

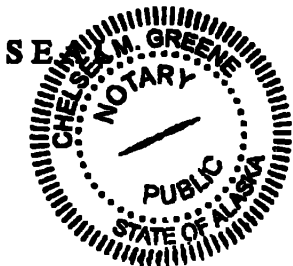
