
On November 4, 2010, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, Scott Rigell for congress ("Committee") and Joseph B. Wood, as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On August 4, 2011, based upon the information contained in the complaint, and information provided by your clients, the Commission decided to dismiss the complaint and closed its file in this matter. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter on August 4, 2011.
