Dear Mr. Jordan:

This letter follows on a complaint send October 25, 2010, which you notified me has been designated MUR 6422. Since I wrote my first letter, post-election reports have been filed and I have had the opportunity to review the one submitted by Missy Smith, as downloaded from the Commission's web site.

Two points are worth noting. First, Ms. Smith reports two contributions from Mr. Richard Retta. The first, dated October 26, 2010 was in the amount of \$2400. The second, dated, the same day, was in the amount of \$200. With this second contribution Mr. Retta exceeded the legally allowable amount. The campaign apparently accepted this excess contribution. The post-election report indicates that a refund in the amount of \$200 was made during the period from the day after the election through the end of the reporting period, but this refund is not itemized on Schedule B. If this was a refund of Mr. Retta's excess contribution, it should have been itemized as the initial contribution was itemized on Schedule A. If it was a different refund, the campaign held onto Mr. Retta's excess contribution for almost four weeks and possibly longer.

In addition, Ms. Smith's report shows a total of \$880 in in-kind contributions received from "Society for Truth and Justice." This at first seems to be a corporation, but it is not registered as such in the District of Columbia (see enclosed printout of a search from the database of the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs). It may, however, be an unincorporated association taxed as a corporation. An internet search turned up no active web site of this "Society," but it appeared on a site (printout enclosed) as the payee for ordering materials promoted by Mr. Randall Terry.

Thus, the publicly available information is incomplete, but this Smith campaign contributor seems likely to be either a corporation (making an illegal corporate contribution), or a fictitious or trade name assumed by either Mr. Terry or another group he is involved with. In the latter

case, I question whether the contribution is properly reported as coming from the Society, rather than disclosing the actual identify of the donor.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief.


