Dear Mr. Schneller:

On November 29, 2010, the Federal Election Commission notified Friends of Jim Schneller for Congress Committee ("Committee") and you in your individual and official capacity as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On November 15, 2011, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by the Committee and you, that there is no reason to believe Friends of Jim Schneller for Congress Committee and you in your individual and official capacity as treasurer, violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and Commission regulations. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003).
