On December 2, 2010, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients Friends of John Loughlin ("Committee") and Mia Caetano Johnson, as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On December 13, 2011, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by you, that there is no reason to believe Friends of John Loughlin and Mia Caetano Johnson, as treasurer, violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003).
