Dear Mr. Hughey,

Subsequent to filing a complaint against the above-named parties, by letter dated December 16, 2010, media reports indicated that Mr. Izzard has claimed in the past to possess a "green card." For example, the *Minneapolis Star-Tribune* noted:

Izzard said in a 2007 newspaper piece that he has a green card and two months ago even tweeted "I'm a Green Card guy paying taxes. Can't vote. Can donate. Can talk sense" and "Yes - Green card and pay taxes" last month in answer to a Twitter question about whether he had "U.S. citizenship/residency, etc."¹

We were not aware of these statements when we filed our original complaint and do not wish to provide the Commission with incorrect or incomplete information. If this information is
