Re: WMUR Television, the New Hampshire Republican Party, and Frank Guinta (Republican Congressman Elect)

Dear Chris,

This is a formal "sworn complaint" brought by me against WMUR television, located in Manchester, New Hampshire, the New Hampshire Republican Party, and Republican Congressman Elect Frank Guinta. I aver that WMUR television violated federal election laws under the FEC's jurisdiction during the 2010 election period when it arbitrarily denied equal television broadcast access opportunity for all federal election candidates during a televised Congressional debatethat was broadcast over the cable television network and federally regulated air space. This violation resulted in fraudulent eleation results that illegally ant/or unfatrly hemafitted sevaral high ranking candidates within the New Hampshire Republican "good ale hoys" network. This process is unfair to New Hampshire voters and to candidates such as myself, and it is inconsistent with the principles of good and proper governance in general.

I specifically aver that Frank Guinta won the 2010 Congressional District OneHouse Seat, based on fraud, and violations of 11 CFR 100.7(b)(2), 100.8(b)(2), 110.13 and 114.4(f), et al. I further aver that Frank Guinta is aware of the fraud involved

in this matter; and therefore, this calls into question Frank's personalethics and character. I would also point out that this is not the first time that issues involving Frank Guinta's personal ethics and character have been raised. Therefore, I respectfully request your immediate assistance in this matter to insure justice for the people of New Hampshire.

I also specifically aver that New Hampshire voters were swindled out of their Congressional District One House Seat by WMUR television, the New Hampshire Republican Party, and Frank Guinta when I was denied of my right to participate in a primary campaign debate hosted and broadcasted by WMUR television. I seek personal penalties and damages against WMUR television, the New Hampshire Republican Party, and Frank Guinta for this, as well as your assistance to ensure that sanctions are brought against them for their federal election violations.

Thank you for your expected cooperation in this most urgent matter, which concerns all registered New Hampshire voters.


