Dear Mr. Baglietto:

On February 24, 2011, the Federal Election Commission notified Liberatore for Congress ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On November 15, 2011, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by the respondents, that there is no reason to believe that the Committee and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a(f). The Commission also dismissed the allegations that the Committee and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Films, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003).
