On March 17, 2011, the Federal Election Commission notified Friends of Jim Bender/Bender for Senate ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.


On October 18, 2011, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by the respondent, that there is no reason to believe that the Committee and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 441a(f) or 441b(a), or underlying regulations. The Commission also dismissed the allegations that the Committee and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b) and 11 C.F.R. § 116.10(a). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.
