On July 28, 2011, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On February 28, 2012, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by you, that there is no reason to believe you violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b regarding a prohibited in-kind contribution. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.
