I am writing in regard to two billboards that are located in Angelina County, Texas. The billboards in question are definitely political signs that have no Disclosure (Disclaimer) printed on them. The billboards clearly state to "VOTE OBAMA OUP". Since President Obama has declared that he will be a candidate for re-election in 2012, this makes the billboards fall under the Federal Election Commission statutes.

One of the billboards is located on the East side of Medford Drive - US 59/US 69 between Texas HWY 103E and FM 325 in Lufkin, Texas. The 2nd billboard is located on the West side of US 59 South of Lufkin at the Burke, Texas city limits. (Just North of Diboll, Texas). Both of the billboards have the same statements printed on them. (A picture of one of the billboards is enclosed.)

The billboards were erected by Mark Hicks at 936-634-2040. He stated to the Lufkin Daily News that the individuals who contracted the billboards wished to remain anonymous.

It is my feeling that the billboards are in violation of the FEC statutes that require any public communications that are for or against a candidate must have the Disclaimer printed on them.

I am requesting that charges of violation of FEC statutes be brought against the persons responsible.

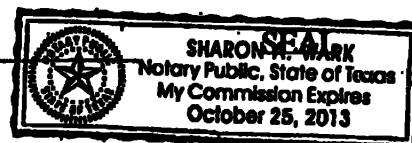
