The Federal Election Commission has considered the allegations contained in your Complaint dated October 28, 2011, and Amended Complaint dated November 2, 2011. After considering the circumstances of the matter, the allegations in your Complaint, Amended Complaint, and the Response submitted on behalf of Gregory W. Meeks, Friends for Meeks and Patsy Simmons in her official capacity as treasurer, and Build America PAC and Patsy Simmons in her official capacity as treasurer, the Commission determined to close the file. Accordingly, on May 21, 2013, the Commission closed the file in this matter. One or more Statements of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70426 (Dec. 18, 2003) and Statement of Policy Regarding Placing First General Counsel's Reports on the Public Record, 74 Fed. Reg. 66132 (Dec. 14, 2009).
