RE: MUR 6511/Additional Information

Dear Mr. Jordan:

In accordance with your letter of December 6, 2011, Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics In Washington ("CREW") would like to submit to the Federal Election Commission ("FEC" or "the Commission") additional information demonstrating that Rep. Robert E. Andrews (D-NJ), his authorized campaign committee, Rob Andrews U.S. House Committee, and Maureen Doherty, in her official capacity as treasurer, knowingly and willfully violated 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b)(2)(E) and 11 C.F.R. § 113.1(g) by using campaign funds to subsidize the fledgling singing career of his daughter, Josie Andrews.

In its November 30, 2011 complaint, CREW alleged that Rep. Andrews repeatedly had used campaign funds to pay for his daughter Josie to travel to Los Angeles to further her career as an aspiring actress and singer, thereby violating 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b)(2) and 11 C.F.R. § 113.1(g). MUR 6511 Complaint at ¶¶ 13, 18 & 19 and Exhibits B and D.


On January 31, 2012, the Rob Andrews U.S. House Committee filed its Year-End Report for 2011 (attached hereto as Exhibit A). The Report disclosed that the Rob Andrews U.S. House Committee spent over \$11,000 for two trips to Los Angeles in November 2011, including more than \$7,000 for airfare, more than \$3,000 for hotel rooms at the Beverly Hills Plaza Hotel, more than \$1,500 for limousines and more than \$200 for meals. See Exhibit A at 137-38, 145-47, 149, 151 and 161-63. *The Philadelphia Inquirer*, the *Cherry Hill Courier Post* and the *New Jersey Herald* all reported that Rep. Andrews' daughter participated in the trip, which coincided with a recording session she had with her Los Angeles production company. See Joelle Farrell, U.S. Rep. Andrews' Travels Under Scrutiny Again, *The Philadelphia Inquirer* (Feb. 11, 2012); Jim Walsh, More Andrews Trips in Question, *Cherry Hill Courier Post* (Feb. 9, 2012); Geoff Mulvihill, Watchdog Wants Spending by US Rep. Andrews Audited, *New Jersey Herald* (Feb. 7, 2012) (attached hereto as Exhibit B).

Accordingly, CREW requests that the Commission expand its investigation in MUR 6511 to include these latest violations of 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b)(2)(E) and 11 C.F.R. § 113.1(g), impose appropriate sanctions and take such further action as may be appropriate, including conducting

an audit of the Rob Andrews for U.S. House committee and/or referring this case to the Department of Justice for criminal prosecution.





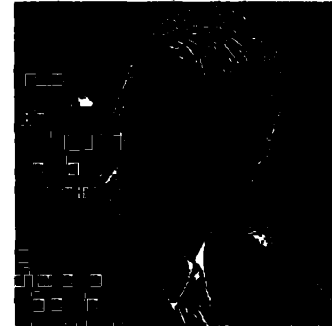
U.S. Rep. Andrews' travels under scrutiny again

U.S. Rep. Rob Andrews' travels are under scrutiny again.

This time, the New Jersey Democrat is drawing criticism for spending \$12,000 in campaign cash for a trip to California that coincided with a music recording session for his 16-year-old daughter, according to his latest campaign-finance filings and the production studio's Facebook page.

Andrews, 54, of Hidden Heights, declined through a spokesman to say with whom he met in California or whether his daughter's activities related to his fund-raising there. He also refused to release receipts for the trip to back up previous claims that he keeps his political and personal expenses separate when he travels with his family.

"The California trip . . . was for the purpose of fund-raising activities and political meetings with members of the higher education community, two separate foreign policy advocacy groups, and various members of the entertainment and legal industries," Andrews' chief of staff, Fran Tagmire, said in a statement. "California has typically been one of the campaign's top states for financial support. The full public disclosure of these legal and proper expenses, including the accompaniment of his minor daughter and her participation, is consistent with the law in all respects."

Andrews raised \$5,028 during the trip, and reported raising an additional \$2,750 from California residents or businesses between Oct. 1, 2011, and the end of the year.

He raised much more - about \$24,000 - from California-linked donors between July 1 and Oct. 31, when he visited California twice with his daughter Josie, an aspiring pop singer.

Andrews, a 22-year veteran of the U.S. House, is up for reelection in November. Republicans are still deciding on a candidate, said Camden County GOP Chairman Thomas Booth Jr. Andrews typically has won reelection with wide margins.

Questions about Andrews' spending practices in recent months have led a congressional watchdog group, Citizens for Ethics and Responsibility in Washington, to call on federal officials to audit his account.

"It's highly suspicious that he would refuse to release records," said Craig Himes, an ethics expert and lobbyist with the nonpartisan group Public Citizen. "If he were complying with the law, you'd think he'd be perfectly willing to disclose records showing his daughter's expenses were paid for with private funds and not campaign funds."

Booth used harsher language.

"I believe that he's using his campaign fund as his own personal piggy bank, and I think it shows a callous disregard for the rules," he said. "I think that it is a symptom of a politician who is way too comfortable and has lost touch with the voters in the First Congressional District."

Andrews first came under fire in November, when it was revealed that he spent \$13,540 to attend a donor's meeting in Scotland, including \$8,725 for three nights at the five-star Admiral Hotel. Andrews took his wife and two daughters with him.

Although Andrews said the trip was a legitimate campaign expense to thank a donor, he repaid the money to his campaign when news media reported on the trip. Andrews then redirected the money to a local organization that helps homeless veterans.

But Andrews has not repaid his campaign for other trips and parties with mixed personal and political purposes.

Andrews made five trips to California in 2011, in February, April, July, August and November, campaign finance reports show. In all, Andrews had recording sessions in April, July, August and November, according to a Facebook page for the music production company Vendetta.

His most recent trip cost \$7,237 in airfare alone, according to the latest report with the Federal Election Commission. That report lists five separate entries for airfare between Philadelphia and California, which Tagmire declined to explain.

Andrews spent \$3,200 on a stay at the Beverly Hills Plaza Hotel, billed between Nov. 9 and 13. He spent nearly \$1,600 on car service from "Best Limo."

Andrews also has spent campaign funds on parties that celebrated himself and his older daughter, Jacquelyn.

In 2009, he spent \$33,000 for a party to celebrate his inauguration to the 111th Congress and Jacquelyn's Sweet Sixteen party, according to campaign finance reports.

In June, he threw a similar bash at his Haddon Heights home to celebrate his 29 years in Congress and Jacquelyn's graduation from the Baldwin School in Bryn Mawr. It cost his campaign \$10,000, according to financial disclosures.

When asked in November about the parties and trips, Andrews said he paid for his daughters' expenses from his own personal accounts, using the campaign cash for political aspects of the events only. He has refused to release receipts.

An invitation received by The Inquirer last fall listed both events in June on the same invitation. It was printed on stationery that read "paid for and authorized by Andrews for Congress."

Members of Congress are forbidden from using campaign funds for personal use, but enforcers such as the FEC give politicians a lot of room to justify their expenses, said Paul S. Ryan, a lawyer with the watchdog group the Campaign Legal Center.

"Joint travel that has taken place for multiple purposes is certainly very common from the president down to the most junior member of the House," he said, adding it's "among the most difficult places to draw lines."

In 2009, the FEC found that Andrews misused his campaign funds for personal use when he bought clothes after an airline lost his luggage. Andrews had repaid the money by the time the agency ruled, so he was not fined or otherwise punished.

CERW sent a letter to the FEC in November asking the agency to audit Andrews. Booth also sent letters to the House Ethics Committee and the U.S. attorney.

More Andrews trips in question

Rep. Rob Andrews used political contributions to make multiple trips to Los Angeles that coincided with recording sessions there for his teenaged daughter, campaign records show.

The Haddon Heights Democrat traveled to the Southern California city five times in 2011 — staying at the Beverly Hills Plaza Hotel in February, June, July, August and November, according to campaign filings with the Federal Election Commission.

Andrews' daughter Josie, an aspiring pop singer, had recording sessions during at least three of those trips, according to online postings from a Los Angeles production company.

The FEC last week released a year-end report that showed Andrews' campaign spent more than \$11,000 for the November visit, including more than \$7,000 in airfare. The previous trips are detailed in reports filed earlier in the year.

The earlier records indicate Andrews' campaign paid almost \$16,000 for lodging, dining and the use of a limo service during the four trips between February and August. The campaign provided more than \$22,000 for air travel around the time of the trips between February and August, although the filings do not disclose flight details.

A Washington-based watchdog group on Wednesday renewed its call for an independent audit of Andrews' campaign spending. Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics (CREW) said an FEC review was needed to determine whether Andrews' trips were personal in nature.

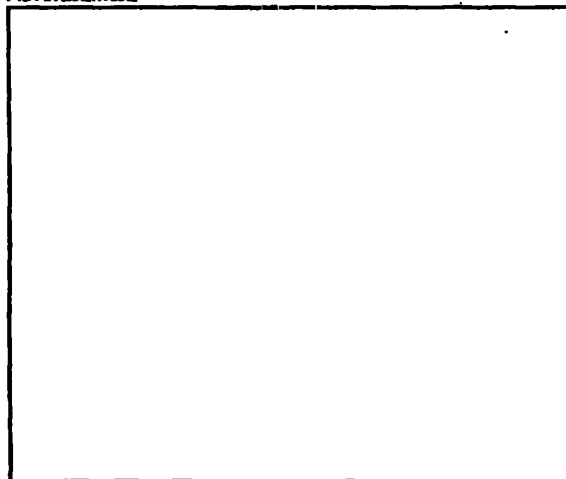
Andrews' spokesman Fran Tagmire on Wednesday said the campaign's spending practices "are fully legal and proper."

Tagmire has said Andrews raised funds in California and attended political meetings there. He said the campaign won't disclose who attended the meetings to respect the privacy of friends and supporters.

"The full public disclosure of these expenses includes any and all expenses related to the campaign," Tagmire said in a statement. "This includes expenses attributable to anyone who accompanies him to campaign events, including a member of his family."

Tagmire did not respond to a question

about whether Josie Andrews had accompanied her father on all five trips to Los Angeles. He also did not address a question about the girl's age. Josie Andrews' s Facebook page says she is 16, but a biography prepared by her mother at an entertainment website, IMDB.com, indicates she is 17.

Online messages posted by Vendetta, a Southern California production firm, show Josie Andrews attended recording sessions in Los Angeles during the trips in July, August and November.

"Today is the day, recording...with super talented artist Josie Andrews," a Vendetta website said on July 19. "Another great two-day session with Josie Andrews," said an Aug. 18 post. And a Nov. 9 message noted the teenager on the next day would be recording her fourth song with Vendetta.

The company's websites, which include an in-studio picture of the singer and her father, don't mention any performances in June or February. However, pictures posted in April show the young singer during an earlier visit. A Vendetta representative could not be reached Wednesday.

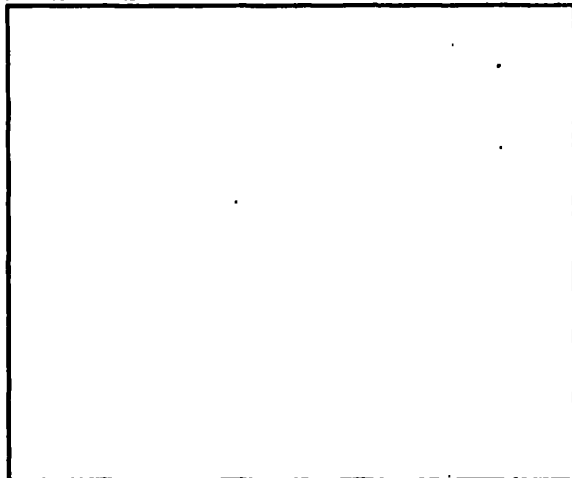
Andrews' spending practices previously spurred controversy after he tapped more than \$13,400 in contributions for a family trip to Scotland last summer. Andrews said the spending was proper because he was attending the wedding of a donor and adviser, but he later repaid the money to his campaign "in order to focus on the

issues affecting our constituents."

CREW has filed a complaint with the FEC over Andrews' use of campaign funds for the Scotland trip. Andrews has called the complaint "baseless."

CREW also filed a complaint in 2009 after Andrews used about \$950 in campaign funds to replace clothing that had been lost by an airline. The FEC said the purchase was improper, but it took no action because Andrews had repaid the money before the complaint was filed.

Watchdog wants spending by US Rep. Andrews audited

HADDONFIELD, N.J. (AP) - A Washington political watchdog is calling for an audit of campaign spending by U.S. Rep. Rob Andrews after examining a finance report that shows the New Jersey Democrat spent \$12,000 for a trip to California last year during which his 16-year-old daughter, an aspiring singer, had a music recording session.

Melanie Sloan, the executive director of Washington-based Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics, says she wants to know whether Andrews had legitimate political business in Los Angeles. She said the Federal Elections Commission should investigate - or perhaps federal prosecutors should.

"It looks bad. It's always possible there's a reasonable explanation," she said. "I doubt his explanation will be sufficient."

Fran Tagmire, a campaign spokesman for Andrews, said in an email that the expenditures were "legal and proper." He said Andrews did fundraising, had political meetings with "members of the higher education community, two separate foreign policy advocacy groups, and various members of the entertainment and legal industries." He did not detail which groups he met with.

And he said that 16-year-old Josie Andrews participated in the trip - though her exact role was not clear.

"The full public disclosure of these legal and proper expenses, including the accompaniment of his minor daughter and her participation, is consistent with the law in all respects," Tagmire said.

Tagmire said California has typically been 1 of Andrews' top states for donations. From October through December of last year, he brought in just under \$200,000 in donations. Of them, \$9,750 were from people or organizations with California addresses.

Andrews flew to Los Angeles and San Diego in mid-November, according to campaign finance filings.

The website of Vendetta, a record company, shows photos of Josie in her music recording session at Paramount Recording Studio in Hollywood in mid-November.

Sloan said that it would be allowable if Andrews did personal business during a fundraising trip. But a disclosure his campaign filed last month with the FEC shows he collected just one contribution from California during that timeframe - a \$5,000 donation from the political action committee of Bridgeport Education Inc., in San Diego.

The records show much more spending than that - including more than \$7,000 for what appears to be several airline tickets between Philadelphia and Los Angeles purchased on Oct. 31 and Nov. 1, \$3,200 at the Beverly Hills Plaza hotel, more than \$1,500 on limousines and under \$100 for meals.

Andrews, a member of Congress since 1990, has come under scrutiny in the past for the way he has used campaign money.

Last year, he reimbursed more than \$13,000 to his campaign to repay money he used to take his family to a wedding in Scotland. His campaign then donated the money to a charity for homeless veterans.

He's been criticized for spending more than \$10,000 last year on a party celebrating his 20 years in Congress and his older daughter's high school graduation. And there was criticism of his campaign's donations of tens of thousands of dollars to Philadelphia theaters - sometimes within months of a daughter appearing in 1 of their productions.
