Dear Mr. Figueroa:

On July 17, 2012, you were notified that the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") found reason to believe that Obama-Biden 2012; Exodo 80, Inc; and you, in your individual capacity, (collectively, "Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 441h(b) and 441d(a), provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971. After considering the circumstances of this matter, the Commission determined on September 10, 2013, to take no further action as to the Respondents, and closed the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003) and Statement of Policy Regarding Placing First General Counsel's Reports on the Public Record, 74 Fed. Reg. 66,132 (Dec. 14, 2009).
