On October 18, 2016, the Commission found reason to believe that Americans for Job Security ("AJS") violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102, 30103, and 30104 by failing to organize, register, and report with the Commission as a political committee in 2010. On March 26, 2019. following an investigation and Second General Counsel's Report, the Commission authorized pre-probable cause conciliation with AJS

and a requirement for AJS to register as a political committee and file disclosure reports.<sup>2</sup> These actions were the culmination of a years-long process, including a remand from the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia.<sup>3</sup> Since the Complaint in this

case was filed in 2012, AJS has become defunct and lost both its corporate<sup>4</sup> and tax-exempt<sup>5</sup> status.
