Dear Mr. Lahood-Sparks:

On March 27, 2012, the Federal Election Commission notified you and The Palazzo Grande, Inc. of a complaint designated MUR 6540 alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act (the "Act") and Commission regulations. The Commission considered the complaint but there were an insufficient number of votes to find reason to believe that The Palazzo Grande, Inc. violated the Act and Commission regulations. Therefore, on May 21, 2013, the Commission closed its file in this matter. A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.

Because the file is now closed, documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003); Statement of Policy Regarding Placing First General Counsel's Reports on the Public Record, 74 Fed. Reg. 66,132 (Dec. 14, 2009).
