Dear Mr. Baran:

On June 12, 2012, the Federal Election Commission notified your client of the complaint in MUR 6589 alleging that American Action Network violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On June 24, 2014, the Commission considered the complaints, but there was an insufficient number of votes to find reason to believe that American Action Network violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 432, 433, and 434. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003) and Statement of Policy Regarding Placing First General Counsel's Reports on the Public Record, 74 Fed. Reg. 66,132 (Dec. 14, 2009). The Commission did not adopt a Factual and Legal Analysis for this case. A Statement of Reasons further explaining the basis for the Commission's decision will follow.
