The Federal Election Commission has considered the allegations contained in your complaint dated March 8, 2012, but there was an insufficient number of votes to find reason to believe American Action Network violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 432, 433, 434. Accordingly, on June 24, 2014, the Commission closed the file in this matter. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003) and Statement of Policy Regarding Placing First General Counsel's Reports on the Public Record, 74 Fed. Reg. 66,132 (Dec. 14, 2009).
