NEW TV ADS IN GA, KY, & WV

Patriot Majority USA Urges Rejection of Ryan Plan to Essentially End Medicare

Wednesday, June 20, 2012 – Patriot Majority USA has begun airing issue ads on TV in Georgia, North Carolina and West Virginia on Monday, June 18, that push back against the Ryan Budget and its plans to essentially end Medicare as we know it.
