You were previously notified that on June 1, 2017, the Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") found probable cause to believe that you knowingly and willfully violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122 and 11 C.F.R. § 110.4(b), provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and Commission regulations, in connection with the captioned matter. As a result of our inability to settle this matter through conciliation within the allowable time period, the Commission has authorized the General Counsel to institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court.
