Dear Mr. Bonya:

On June 8, 2016, your client, PBS Coals, Inc. was notified of the Complaint in this matter and informed that the Federal Election Commission had found reason to believe that Unknown Respondents had violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30104(c)(1), 30104(g), and 30120(a) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 109.10 and 110.11. The Commission notified you that it had information suggesting your clients were responsible for some of the communications at issue. On June 28, 2016 you submitted a response to this notification.

After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on March 5, 2019, to substitute PBS Coals, Inc. into the prior findings as to Unknown Respondents, but to take no further action other than to admonish your client for violating the Federal Election Campaign Act. The Commission closed the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.
