On November 7, 2012, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, No on Government Waste/No on Measure B — Major Funding by Manwin USA, of a complaint alleging that it had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On March 17, 2015, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to dismiss the allegations your client violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121 (formerly 2 U.S.C. § 441e). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003); Statement of Policy Regarding Placing First General Counsel's Reports on the Public Record, 74 Fed. Reg. 66,132 (Dec. 14, 2009).
