On November 7, 2012, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, Mindgeek S.A.R.L. f.k.a. Manwin Licensing International S.A.R.L; Mindgeek USA Incorporated f.k.a. Manwin USA, Inc.; Fabian Thylmann; Andrew Link; Froytal Services Limited, of a complaint alleging that they had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On March 17, 2015, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to dismiss the allegations your clients violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121 (formerly 2 U.S.C. § 441e). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed.
