Dear Messrs. Josefiak and Bayes:

On April 26, 2013, the Federal Election Commission notified you of an amended complaint alleging that Crossroads Grassroots Policy Strategies ("Crossroads GPS") had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On November 17, 2015, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to approve the Office of General Counsel's recommendations to find no reason to believe that Crossroads GPS violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(c)(2) and 11 C.F.R. § 109.10(e)(1)(vi) and dismiss the allegation that Crossroads GPS violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(c)(2). Accordingly, on December 17, 2015, the Commission closed the file in this matter.
