I wanted to follow up on our conversation on March 26, 2015. Have you spoken with Jesse Jackson, Jr.? As we discussed on March 26, the Office of General Counsel hopes to ascertain whether Mr. Jackson would be willing to produce any documents to us or speak with us to resolve the Commission's outstanding factual questions in our investigation in MUR 6766. We also want to know whether Mr. Jackson would be interested in conciliating with the Commission prior to a finding of probable cause to believe that a violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act occurred.

You had told me that after you spoke with Mr. Jackson, you plan to withdraw as Mr. Jackson's counsel before the Commission. If that is still the case, please send me an e-mail indicating your withdrawal, and let me know whether I should contact Jesse directly, or if he has retained new counsel whom I should contact instead.
