On December 12, 2013, your client was notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that she knowingly and willfully violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102(b)-(c), 30104 and 30114, as well as 11 C.F.R. §§ 102.15 and 113.1(g). After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on March 5, 2019 to take no further action as to your client and close the file in this matter.
