Dear Mr. Jordan,

This is in response to your June 5 2014 email, the first notification received by the current Treasurer of MUR 6793. If possible, I would like additional time to respond.

We contacted our website designer to inquire about these allegations. They informed us that they used our website as part of a template they used to build websites for other customers, and that one of these customers was the Center for American Future.

No donations to Steve Stockman for Senate were ever redirected to the Center for American Future or any other party. The source cited for the claim of the "security gap," Lee Stranahan, is by trade a pornographer and blogger, not an information technology professional, and apparently lacks the ability to distinguish a nonworking template from a "security gap."

The complaint describes Jason Posey as "former Campaign Treasurer for Steve Stockman for Senate." Jason Posey was never Treasurer for Steve Stockman for Senate, the Treasurer for Steve Stockman for Senate has been Dan Backer for the entire time from its creation until the past month, a fact that can be easily obtained from examination of records maintained and made available to the public by the Federal Election Commission.

There was no illegal "coordination between Steve Stockman for Senate and third parties," or any other violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Thus, the Federal Election Commission should take no further action on this complaint, which appears to have originated as part of a desperate scheme by Complainant to place second in the election which took place a few days after he filed the complaint.
