I apologize for the late response. There is one correction I would like on the record.

""According to the Complaint, Stockman coordinated with the founder of CAF, Jason Posey, who had previously served as treasurer of Stockman's Senate committee, Steve Stockman for Senate and Daniel Wholihan in his official capacity as treasurer ("Committee,") Respondents denied the allegations, supported by posey,s sworn affidavit""

The Treasurer at the time of the complaint by Texans for Stovall filed was Dan Backer and the complaint I saw mentioned his name. I (Daniel Wholihan) was not involved with the committee until 2-28-2015 after Mr. Stockman's primary election concluded in 2014 (and I was not part of the criminal investigation in any fashion). I answered the supplemental complaint given to me in my official capacity as treasurer based on the information given to me, but that is my only involvement related to the Texans for Stovall complaint.
