On March 25, 2014, the Federal Election Commission notified David Vitter for U.S. Senate and you in your official capacity as treasurer (the "Committee") of a complaint alleging that the Committee had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On March 26, 2019, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe the Committee violated 52 U.S.C. § 30125(e). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016. One or more Statements of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.
