Dear Mr. Warrington:

On June 30, 2016, you were notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that your client, Ron Paul 2012 Presidential Campaign Committee, Inc., and its treasurer in their official capacity ("Committee"), knowingly and willfully violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30118 and 30104(b)(5). On March 26, 2019, you were notified that the Commission had determined to enter into pre-probable cause conciliation with the Committee. After considering the circumstances of this matter, the Commission determined on January 11, 2022, to close the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
