18 Attached is a proposed conciliation agreement that resolves the Commission's prior
19 findings that there was reason to believe that Americans for Job Security ("AJS") violated
20 52 U.S.C. § 30104(c)(2)(C) and 11 C.F.R. § 109.10(e)(1)(vi) by failing to disclose that the
21 Center to Protect Patient Rights ("CPPR") provided funds for the purpose of furthering
22 independent expenditures. See Certification, MUR 6816 (AJS) (June 23, 2015). We recommend
23 that the Commission accept the negotiated agreement and close the file as to AJS.
