I, Laura E. Sinram, recording secretary of the Federal Election Commission executive session, do hereby certify that on August 11, 2021, the Commission took the following actions in the above-captioned matter:

1. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:
 - a. Take no further action against Cal Voters for Honest Government and Johnny Diaz, Jr. in his official capacity as treasurer and issue an admonishment letter, as recommended in the Second General Counsel's Report dated June 7, 2021.
 - b. Instruct the Reports Analysis Division to administratively terminate Cal Voters for Honest Government.
 - c. Approve the appropriate letters.
 - d. Close the entire file.

Commissioners Broussard, Walther, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion.

Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor dissented.

2. Decided by a vote of 4-2 to:

Dismiss the allegations against Cal Voters for Honest Government and Johnny Diaz, Jr. in his official capacity as treasurer pursuant to the statute of limitations.

Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, Trainor, and Walther voted affirmatively for the decision. Commissioners Broussard and Weintraub dissented.

3. Decided by a vote of 6-0 to:

- a. Instruct the Reports Analysis Division to administratively terminate Cal Voters for Honest Government.
- b. Approve the appropriate letters.
- c. Close the file.

Commissioners Broussard, Cooksey, Dickerson, Trainor, Walther, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the decision.
