Cal Voters for Honest Government and Johnny Diaz, Jr. in his official capacity as treasurer

Dear Mr. Diaz:

On May 15, 2019, you were notified that the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") found reason to believe that Cal Voters for Honest Government and you in your official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C.§§ 30120 and 30124(b) ("the Committee") by failing to include proper disclaimers on the Committee's website and billboards and by fraudulently soliciting funds. After conducting an investigation and considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on August 11, 2021, to dismiss the matter pursuant to the statute of limitations, instructed the Reports Analysis Division to administratively terminate the Committee, and closed the file.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.
