I. INTRODUCTION

On April 16, 2015, the Commission found probable cause to believe that Arvin Black ("Respondent") violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30122 and 30116(a) by making excessive contributions in the names of others in the amount of \$9,600 to Friends of Mike Lee (the "Committee"). The Commission authorized the Office of General Counsel to attempt to settle these violations through probable cause conciliation and approved a proposed conciliation agreement. Attached is a revised agreement negotiated with Respondent which would resolve the violations. We recommend that the Commission accept the negotiated agreement and close the file as to Arvin
