**CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME
TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT**

As consideration for the Federal Election Commission granting an extension to respond to the General Counsel's Brief in this matter, Respondent, John Swallow, hereby consents to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement suit that the Commission might institute pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6) for a period of 14 days.

This agreement will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit for a period of 14 calendar days from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462 or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in this matter.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of the Respondent.
