Dear Mr. Black:

On June 30, 2014, the Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") notified you of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On November 18, 2014, the Commission voted to find reason to believe that you violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122. After engaging in pre-probable cause conciliation, on July 17, 2015, the Commission notified you that it had accepted your signed conciliation agreement and closed the file as to you. The Commission also explained that it would notify you when the entire file had been closed. At that time, it provided you with a copy of the fully executed conciliation agreement

Due to an administrative oversight, there was a delay in the formal closure of this matter. Accordingly, this is to advise you that the file in this matter has been closed and this matter is now public. Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
