Dear Mr. Black:

On June 30, 2014, the Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") notified you of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On June 18, 2015, the Commission decided to dismiss the allegation that you violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122 and close the file as to you. On June 23, 2015, the Commission notified you of its determination and that it would notify you when the entire file had been closed. At that time, it provided a Factual and Legal Analysis explaining the basis of its decision.

Due to an administrative oversight, there was a delay in the formal closure of this matter. Accordingly, this is to advise you that the file in this matter has been closed and this matter is now public. Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters*, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
