My Complaint: My Opponent Democrat Candidate Juan Vargas, was aided to election in 2012 to the U.S. Congress by an illegal cash contribution of \$30,000. Complainant is not privileged to specifics; but infers from the Indictment: (1) Source of the donation was illegal. (2) Mr. Vargas, the apparent benefactor, knew about it and knew it was an illegal, indirect contribution but did not report it. (3) A Democrat Political Committee, the same as indirectly identified by a federal agent, refuses to acknowledge it was the recipient of the money and used it to help Vargas campaign of 2012. This complainant further alleges "foot dragging" and fears resolution of complaints will come too late to benefit his campaign.

Buttrressing my complaint is a news story in The San Diego Union Tribune, a major newspaper: The Federal Election Commission has already been notified of allegations similar to the charges herein.

Substantiating Document INDICTMENT Filed 2014 AUG 12 involving
U.S. District Court Case No. 14CR0388-MMA

Background: Federal Prosecutor here in San Diego obtained the referenced Grand Jury Indictment naming Jose Susumo Azano Matsura and others. QUOTING the indictment Page 9, line 27 : On or about September 24, 2012, at JOSE SUSUMO AZANO MATSURA's direction Marc Chase wrote a \$30,000 check to a political party committee associated with Candidate 2's campaign for federal office. Candidate 2 is named elsewhere in the Indictment as: Jose Vargas, Incumbent Member of the U.S. House of Congress. Mr. Vargas is also my Opponent.

As a Candidate for federal office, I see this as unfair, possibly illegal campaigning by my opponent. If the Commission's Counsel finds such irregularities, I further seek public disclosure of such. If subsequent sanctions are appropriate, they should be made public or disclosed publicly so as to be useful to me in my campaign.

I request appropriate action in a timely manner considering the nearness of the Election Date.
