**CONSENT TO EXTEND TIME  
TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL ENFORCEMENT ACTION**

Respondent José Susumo Azaño Matsura hereby consents to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement action that the Federal Election Commission might institute in connection with MUR 6865, pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6), for an indefinite period of time until one hundred and twenty (120) days following the issuing of an opinion by the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the appeal of his criminal conviction and sentence in the case entitled *United States v. Matsura*, 3:14-cr-00388 (S.D. Cal.).

This action will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit from the expiration date of the Consent to Extend Time to Institute a Civil Law Enforcement Action signed by Respondent on January 9, 2018. This action will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit for a period of one hundred twenty (120) calendar days from the date the Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit issues an opinion in the matter of Azaño's appeal of his criminal conviction and sentence, or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable.

Any further extensions of the time to institute a civil enforcement action will require the written consent of the Respondent.
