
On August 19, 2015, your client, Ernesto Encinas, was notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that he violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30121(a)(2) and 30122 by knowingly and willfully assisting in the making of a contribution or donation by a foreign national, and assisting a person in the making of a contribution in the name of another. On September 1, 2015, you submitted a written response to the Commission's findings.

After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on July 17, 2018, to take no further action as to your client and closed the file as it pertains to him.

You are advised that the confidentiality provisions of 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(12)(A) remain in effect, and that this matter is still open with respect to other respondents. The Commission will notify you when the entire file has been closed.
